#### \*Note

A Tier's mid-semester recess usually occurs after 9 teaching weeks. However this may vary depending on that Tier's student production schedule. For example, one Tier may have 8 teaching weeks - recess - 10 teaching weeks.

Occasionally a Tier may need 2 weeks mid-semester recess to accommodate their production, together with 18 teaching weeks. The above break dates are approximate only.

For the Advanced Diploma, the Tiers start at Tier 3, following on from the common units covered in Tier 1 and Tier 2 of the Diploma.
